I would like to take the opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Daniel Lipsey. I am a Lieutenant with the Prince George's County Police Department. I am currently assigned to the District II, Upper Marlboro Station. I am writing this to inform you that we have instituted a new community policing philosophy at our station, which is going to affect the way we deliver police service to you and your community.

We are instituting Community Service Areas, commonly referred to as CSA's. The Patrol district is being broken into 5 different areas. In these areas officers are being assigned to work a specific area of responsibility. By doing this, it will help foster a relationship between the community and the Police Department, that will help to reduce crime. In the past, there was only one officer assigned to an area as a Community Police Officer. Under this new program, your area will now have approximately 25 Community Police Officers. I have been given the CSA which is responsible for the Largo, Kettering, Mitchville, Woodmore, and the Springdale area. Also assigned to this area, are 3 supervisors. They are Sgt. Douglas Epperson, Sgt. Amal Awad, and Acting Sgt. Terry Nelson. You can rest assured that we are all committed to working with you and the community, to reduce crime and create a safe environment. Community Policing involves forming a partnership with the community. With that in mind, we need as much input from the community as we can get.
